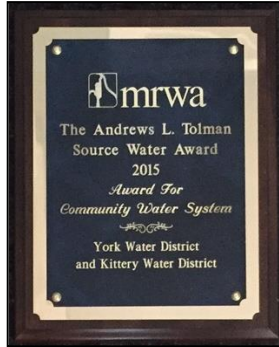


## 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Andrews L. Tolman Source Water Protection Award.



On December 9<sup>th</sup>, 2015 the York Water District and Kittery Water District were presented with the 1<sup>st</sup> annual “Andrews L. Tolman Source Water Protection Award” from Maine Rural Water Association in Bangor at their 35<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference.

This honor is presented to Community Water Systems that demonstrate innovation, effectiveness and sustainability in protecting their drinking water source. York Water District and Kittery Water District combined preserve and protect more than 4,300 acres of watershed land surrounding six ponds and reservoirs to provide high quality drinking water for thousands of consumers in York, Kittery and Eliot.

The two Districts and their customers and consumers benefit from the Districts’ long history of collaboration on water quality, distribution and source water protection issues.
