YORK COUNTY — York County Emergency Management Agency Director Robert C. Bohlmann was recently presented with the first Michael R. Nadeau Award.

Presented by the Southern Maine Regional Water Council, the award recognizes an exemplary commitment to partnerships and regional initiatives within the public sector. As the leader of the York County Emergency Management Agency, Bohlmann has strengthened the outreach of the county communication center and works closely with various organizations to coordinate resources and recovery efforts.

This award was established by the Southern Maine Regional Water Council in honor of its first president, Michael R. Nadeau.

Nadeau throughout his career demonstrated that regional solutions were in the best interest of the public.

The council was formed in 2005 as a result of utility-sponsored legislation to encourage regional solutions for public water delivery. It is made up of seven water utilities: Biddeford-Saco Water Company, Kennebunk-Kennebunkport and Wells Water District, Kittery Water District, Portland Water District, Sanford Water District, South Berwick Water District, and York Water District.

These seven utilities serve approximately 300,000 people in 23 communities, or 25 percent of Maine's population.
