



TREATMENT REPORT

By: Noah Emery



The average precipitation for the month of January is 2.85 inches. We received 8.22 inches of rain which is considered extremely wet. This breaks last January's record of 7.63 inches as the wettest January in the past 30 years and continues a very wet winter as the pond continued to overflow the entire month. NOAA is predicting below average precipitation for February so this trend may subside next month. The color and turbidity of the raw water remains higher than years past but is slowly inching back towards more normal levels.

One big project in the plant this January was what, unfortunately, seems like an annual occurrence now, the removal and rebuild of the clarifier screens. There has been an ongoing issue of clarifier media leaking by the gasket material during the air scour sequence of the clarifier flush. During normal operation there is no leakage but during the clarifier cleaning cycle some media is lost. Operators have tried multiple variations of reinstalling the gasket material in hopes

of averting this, but ultimately it only last a few months to a year before media starts leaking again. We have talked to the manufacturer as well as other District's with the same style plant who have had similar issues but have not found any differences in our techniques or the major culprit of the issue. The good thing about this particular rebuild is that we were able to fill the



media.

clarifier back to its original media depth of four feet using the media that we purchased in the summer of 2023. We would like to thank Larry and Cole for their assistance in this job!

Another task completed this past month was the review and update of the Dam Emergency Action Plan (EAP). We are required by the State to update this every two years. While the State approved our update they offered their assistance in consolidating the plan to make it more user friendly and easier to update. We are gladly accepting their offer and are eager to await their recommendations.

Time was also spent this month reorganizing the plant office to incorporate a new cubicle as well as starting the year end production numbers and state reporting.

GIS REPORT

Data from a collection of property owners has been sent to me so I can insert the data into the Search & Rescue Map. After I inserted these updates I plotted a large copy of the map for inhouse review. Zach, Don and Gary have reviewed the map and created a list of changes. Some of these changes will require a watershed site visit to collect data on some missing trails and landmarks or some can be done within ArcGIS Pro. Once the changes the District would like to see have been made, I will plot another version of the map and we will setup a future

meeting with the remaining property owners so they also have an opportunity to review the map and, if needed, make any additional changes before we finalize the map.

I have also finished a Chases Pond sampling map. The map was created in ArcGIS Pro and will be shared with Zach and the treatment plant staff. An initial review of the map was done and there have been a few more sampling locations that will need to be added to this map before we can finalize it.

As you are all well aware a lead service line inventory letter went out right before the Christmas holiday and to date we have gotten a really positive response from our customers. Some of the picture submissions that we received needed to be retaken for various reason but mostly due to the picture being out of focus. Some even took pictures of their backflow preventer instead of the water line, but thankfully we are reaching out to those customers and asking them to retake the picture and we usually get it back the same day. As of February 8th, we have completed 820 service line inventories on the public and private side, 232 service lines have been identified on the public side only and 540 service lines have been identified on the private side only. I expect the public side will see a jump in the next few months.

The picture I have included in my report is the EPA spreadsheet. This is what we will be submitting to the EPA on October 16th. The screenshot shows all the connected services on High

A lot of time in January was dedicated to vehicle maintenance at the RPO.

A lot of time in January was dedicated to vehicle maintenance at the Resource Protection Office (RPO). As January is typically a slower time of year, I was able to get Robbie to help with many repairs and maintenance issues over the month that came up or we had tracked over the course of the summer. The rear brake rotor was replaced in the 2017 Honda Rincon which corrected brake rattling that began this summer, as well as putting the tracks it for the wintertime. The side-by-side had all 4 tires replaced to a thicker set that will last longer than the stock tires. A coolant line wore through during one of Gary Stevens patrols which Robbie was able to fix quickly along with performing a routine oil change, air filter check, and valve adjustment to

get it running in perfect condition again. The 2015 Rincon received a suspension rebuild, new shock bearings, front ball bearings and an oil change. With all the repairs completed we are now just on a maintenance schedule to keep the vehicles up and running. I was glad we where able to fit all the work into the month between the ATV Law Enforcement Grant when the vehicles get heavier use, and it is more critical all vehicles are useable.

A few other items worth mentioning this month include meeting with Richard Boston and Don to award the 2023 Josiah Chase Clean Water Scholarship to Matthiew Charpentier on behalf of the District. Also, due to the weather this month, I was able to practice plowing out the RPO, the tower site, and the watershed gates which I did not have a chance to do last year. I was also able to update the patrol report data sheets using techniques that Patrick showed me to streamline the monthly and annual summary processes in Excel that will be a great time saver.

DISTRIBUTION REPORT

The standby person received a call on Friday the 12th at 3:00 pm regarding water boiling up in front of 21 Reserve Street. Upon arrival he determined that there was a break on the cast ironwater main. We called in all available crew members and an emergency DigSafe request was called in. After excavating to the main, we found

that there was a full circle break that we were able to repair with a full circle repair clamp. The crew was done and back to the shop by 11:00 pm. We have had several breaks over the years on this main. The last one was two years ago. The main is scheduled to be replaced in the spring of 2025.

On Monday the 15th, the standby person received a call to shut off the domestic and fire service for the Sunrise Motel on Long Sands Road due to a leak. The domestic two-inch valve was an old-style valve and he was unable to get it to turn off. After shutting off the fire service, the packing on the six-inch valve began to leak. The leak was significant. We called in the crew to excavate and repair the valve. We were hoping to repack the valve, but unfortunately the top plate holding the packing in was cracked. Being the valve was installed in 1964 we did not have any parts to repair it. The next option was to replace the valve. Everything ended up being the worstcase scenario. It took time to get the ground water under control. We started at 3:30 pm on Monday. By the time we had the new six-inch valve installed and backfilled the crew was back at the shop at 5:00 am Tuesday morning. The crew excavated and replaced the two-inch on Wednesday.
