POLICY MEMORANDUM #14

TO: Individuals requesting service from the District's water mains.

FROM: Superintendent, David C. Michniewicz

SUBJECT: Test borings for main extensions.

In accordance with the Maine Public Utilities Commission's Chapter #65 Section 3.A., we are required to prepare a cost estimate for potential customers. To accomplish this we need to have sub-surface information (Test-Borings) to determine how much or if any ledge might be involved. Therefore, a regular Trustee's meeting held on August 10, 1987 the Board voted unanimously to require test boring for proposed water main extensions to serve individuals.
